- Prepare and submit VAT returns in line with local regulations
- Maintain the fixed asset register, general ledger and all sub-ledgers
- Reconcile inter-company balances with group headquarters on a monthly basis
- Monitor and maintain customer and vendor accounts, including open item tracking
- Prepare quarterly and annual financial statements and reports
- Ensure compliance with accounting standards, tax regulations, and internal policies
- Coordinate and support internal and external audits, including annual audit preparation
- Manage petty cash in local and foreign currencies
