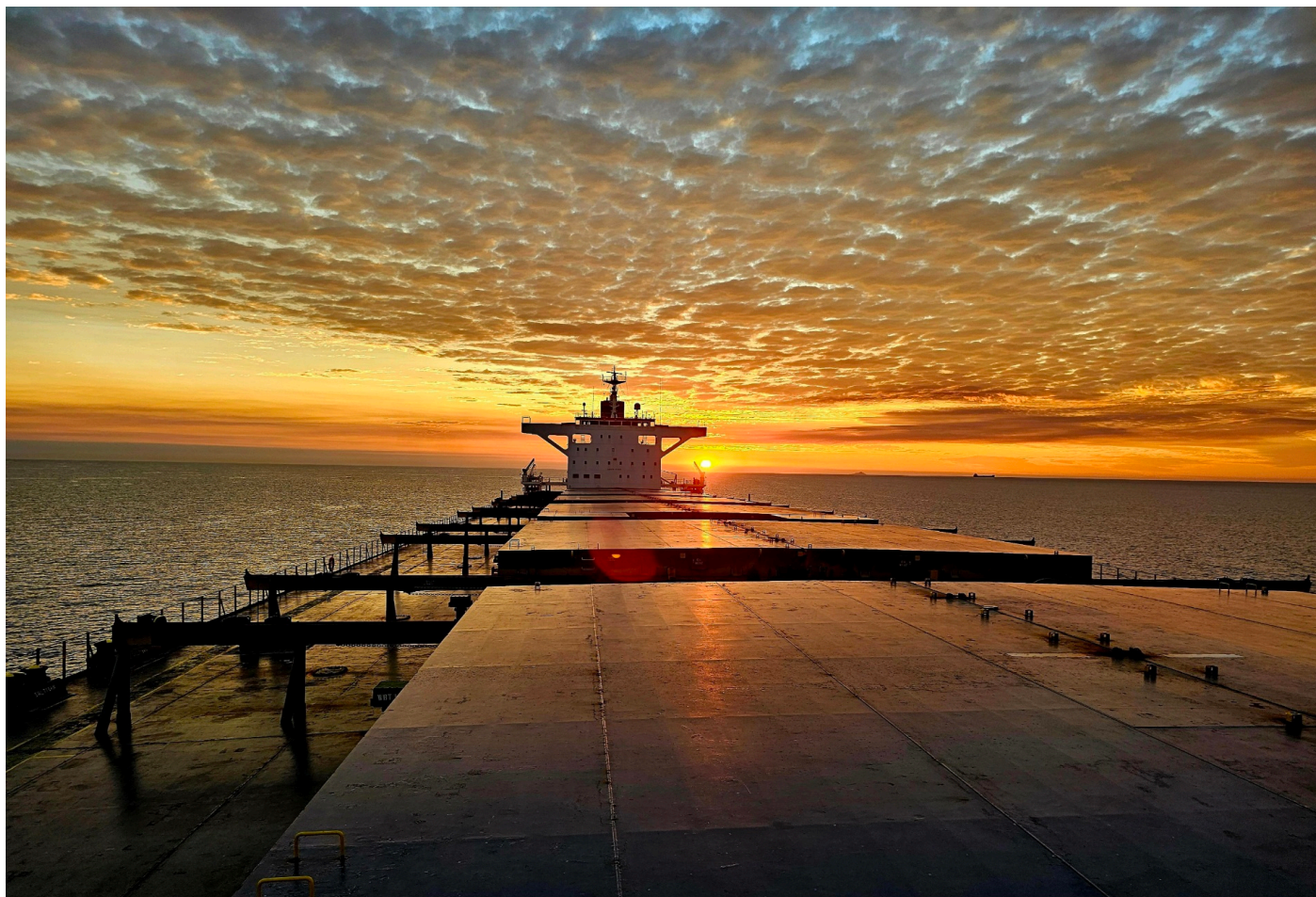




Iron Ore Analyst (f/m/d)
